

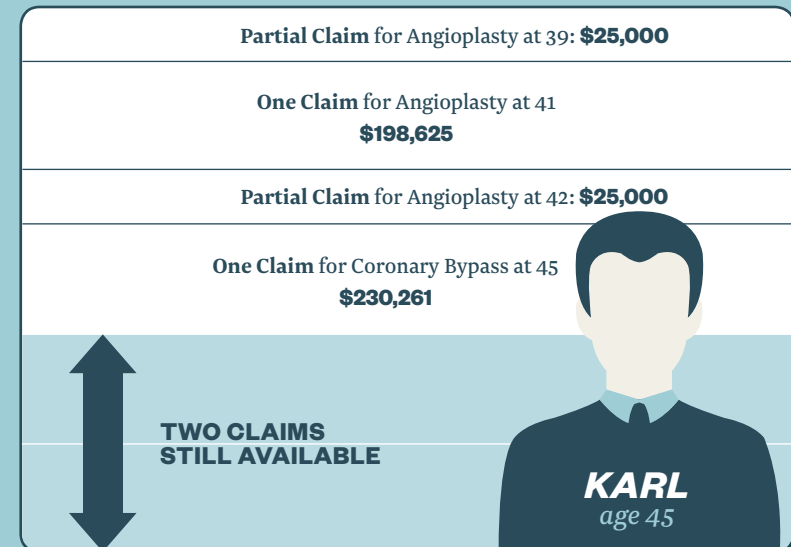
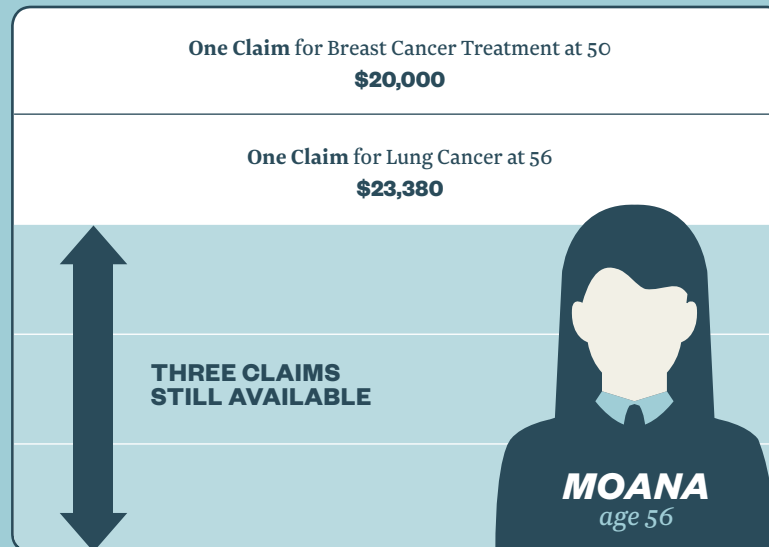
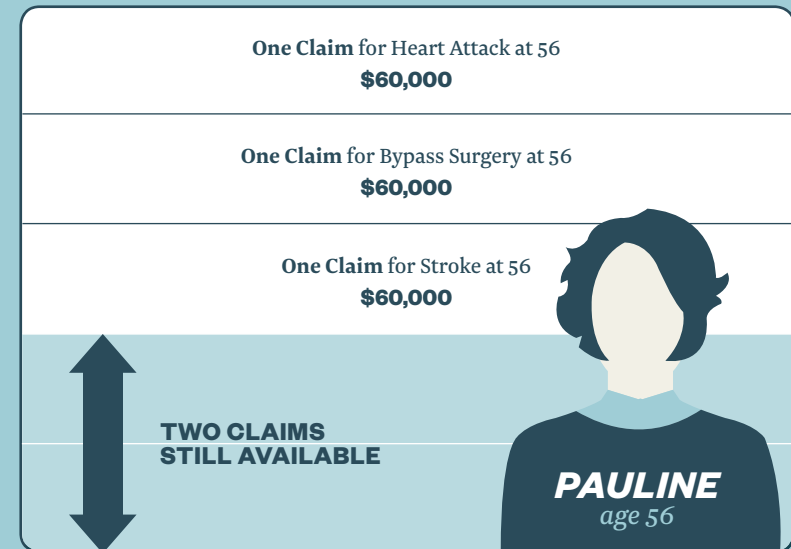
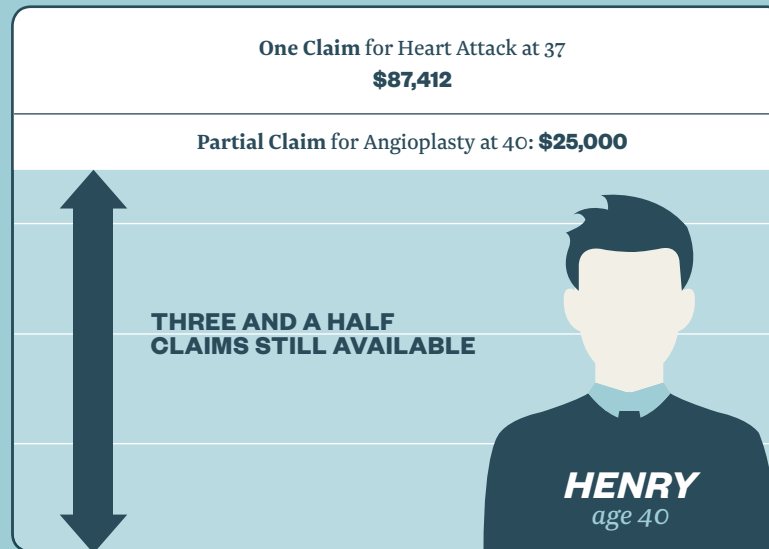
TRAUMA MULTI

Take a look at a few real life examples of how Trauma Multi works.

A Full Benefit payment is 20% (counted as one claim) and a Partial Benefit payment is 10% (counted as half a claim) of the Trauma Multi Cover sum insured. Partial Benefit payment is an advance payment of the Full Benefit where these are related (up to certain limits). A maximum of five claims can be paid during the period of cover. New claims for the same condition must be an unrelated separate event, and there must be at least six months between them.

Note, benefit amounts may vary due to changing Sum Assured over time. For full details please see the Fidelity Life Trauma Multi policy wording.
